- **Award winners will be announced** and finalists will be recognized at the Indiana Campus Compact Annual Awards Gala on Monday, February 27, 2017 at the Indianapolis Marriott North. **You must attend the Award Gala to receive your award.**
- All applicants must register for the Gala by January 15, 2017. Registration is free for each award applicant and a guest. Instructions for registration will be sent to all award applicants in December.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Any professional staff member from an Indiana Campus Compact member institution may apply or be nominated for the Community Service Director Award by submitting the following documents:

- Attached application Cover Sheet with completed background information;
- Applicant essay (no longer than three pages) which addresses the guidelines outlined on the application cover sheet;
- One letter of support from a student, faculty or staff member, or dean from your college or university;
- One letter of support from a community partner;
- Curriculum vitae or resume' (**no longer than five pages**).
- 300 dpi print quality photo for publicity.

The winner will receive a cash gift of \$500.00 and we encourage him/her to donate a portion to an Indiana-based community partner in order to further its service to the community, and use the remainder to support his/her community-based projects.

All materials must be submitted in **one pdf file** to iccgrant@iupui.edu with 2017 *Community Service Director Award* in the subject line.

Faxes and hard copy submissions will not be accepted.

- describe any innovative programming that you have created and/or implemented which has benefitted the campus and the community and discuss the outcomes - include qualitative information such as quotes and stories along with quantitative information; and
- provide evidence of your own commitment to offering your professional service in meeting a community need and long-term solutions.
